A. DEFINITIONS

Series Definitions

a.1. The FM Championship is an open wheel Modified class version of F1 racing.

Eligible Cars

a.2. Any 1:28-1:24 scale version of a Mini-Z F1 car, subject to Technical Regulations (Sec E).

B. PRE-RACE

Scrutineering

b.1. Cars must be provided to the inspector for Scrutineering prior to the race.

C. RACE EVENT

c. 1. An event is made up of three points paying races. Two "Qualifiers" races and a "Grand Prix". All races begin from a standing start.

Q1

c.2. Cars grid in order of points or randomly if no points are yet scored. Q1 shall be five minutes in duration.

Q2

c.3. Cars grid in the finish order from Q1. Q2 shall be five minutes in duration.

Grand Prix

c.4. Cars grid in the finish order from Q2. The Grand Prix shall be 10 minutes in duration.

D. SCORING

d.2. If multiple Heats are run, determine points as though all cars ran together based on lap data.

d.3 Bonus Points

Bonus Points are awarded to the driver setting the fastest lap of a Round, and to each driver that lead a lap in a Round.

Fastest lap = 1 points

Lead a lap = 1 points

d.4. Fastest lap tie awards the bonus to all drivers recording that time.

d.5. If multiple Heats are run, determine points as though all cars ran together based on lap data.

"Lead a Lap" bonus is only scored from the leader Heat. Only one "Fastest Lap" bonus is scored regardless of which Heat it was set in.

E. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Chassis

e.1. Any F1 style 1:28-1:24 scale chassis of any material. May be modified freely.

Body

e.2. Any shell representing an F1 style body. Front and rear wing must be scale appropriate.

e.3. Anti-rail-snagging bumpers may be added but must be fixed. No moving parts. Protective/strengthening parts permitted.

Electronics

e.4. Any control board. No driver aids (ie gyro)

Motor

e.5. Any 70t or greater (ie 80t) 130 class brush or 3500kv or less brushless motor.

Batteries

e.6. AAA in four cell arrangement, max 6.0v or LiPo in 1S or 2S arrangement, Max 8.4v.

Tyres

e.7. Any rubber tyre. The traction patch may be no wider than 11mm front and 14mm rear.

e.8. No traction compounds. Tyre warmers are allowed.

Weight

e.9. Cars must weigh a minimum of 140g race-ready with batteries installed.
